Applications will be accepted following our AGM in February with a closing date of July 31st from there, the grant or loan will be issued in the autumn. The amount of funds available will vary from year to year and depends on the success of the previous year's fundraising activities. This year, 2015, the grant will be \$1700.00

 - a. Raise awareness about food security?
 - b. Increase access to local healthy food
 - c. Impact knowledge and skills relating to local food?
 - d. Expand capacity within the community to address local food security?
 - e. Enhance development and use of policy supporting community food security?
